TITLE: Logical texts and logical manuscripts of the early Middle Ages

SHORT DESCRIPTION: (min 500 MAX 2000 characters)

The laboratory focuses on the analysis and commentary of some relevant logical texts produced in the early Middle Ages, between the 11^{th} and 12^{th} century, and of the manuscripts containing them.

The first part of the activities will consist in 4 hours of lectures presenting the historical-philosophical background of these texts, together with a presentation of the main paleographical and codicological features of the *codices* that will be the object of analysis.

The second part of the activities (8 hours) will consist in the workshop "Logical texts and logical manuscripts of the early Middle Ages", which will host some internationally renowned experts in the history of medieval logic and in the study of logical manuscripts of the High Middle Ages.

All activities, for a total of 12 hours, will be conducted in English.
