### DISCIPLINARY LABORATORY

**TITLE: Logical texts and logical manuscripts of the early Middle Ages**

**INSTRUCTOR: Irene Binini**

**CFU: 2**

**SHORT DESCRIPTION:** (min 500 MAX 2000 characters)

The laboratory focuses on the analysis and commentary of some relevant logical texts produced in the early Middle Ages, between the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> century, and of the manuscripts containing them.

The first part of the activities will consist in 4 hours of lectures presenting the historical-philosophical background of these texts, together with a presentation of the main paleographical and codicological features of the *codices* that will be the object of analysis.

The second part of the activities (8 hours) will consist in the workshop “**Logical texts and logical manuscripts of the early Middle Ages**”, which will host some internationally renowned experts in the history of medieval logic and in the study of logical manuscripts of the High Middle Ages.

All activities, for a total of 12 hours, will be conducted in English.
